## **Matters Arising:**

<u>001 Police Report</u> -

However, the chairman did not think it appropriate for the Community Council to become involved with employing youth workers & the difficulties attached there to.

## <u>005 Ceiriog Valley First Responders Team</u>:

Cllr. Freya Evans Swogger had attended the meeting in Y Ganolfan Ceiriog re. the project re-starting in the Ceiriog Valley. Whilst she was unable to be a first-responder, she would be very happy to be a co-ordinator. Cllr Swogger had also discovered that the defibrillator could be registered with the first-responders who will maintain it.

<u>006 Street Lighting</u>: The clerk has investigated the light outside the school (number 7) remaining out of order. Wrecsam street lighting report that the fault is a mains supply issue which has been raised with Scottish Power previously & they will again bring this to their attention.

<u>007 A.O.B</u>: Cllr EW Morris brought to the Council's attention the terrible state of the Cwmclyd to Springhill road. The clerk would endeavour to organise a site meeting with Dave Pugh.
