Matters Arising

112 Police Report –

No PCSO present & no police report received since the last meeting. Kingdom Report (litter & dog fouling) visited the area on 5, 18, 23 & 30th May). No tickets issued. Cllr E Own reported that the litter on the Cwm road was terrible.

113 Ambulance Response Times –

this concerns many people in the communities along the valley & there were many examples of long response times (1 ½ - 3 hours). Cllr Benning reported that the problem was complex. If the hospital A&E dept. was unable to process patients, then Ambulances have to stay; they can't get out, thus leading to long response times. Cllr Bates (WCBC) is organising a meeting with Welsh Ambulance Services NHS Trust on 12 July. T.B.C.
Defibrillator – we are awaiting news from Jane Claybrook & Welsh Hearts.

114 Finance/Bank –

Balance at 3rd June £6318.24; outstanding cheques £510.00 = balance of £5808.24.
Insurance has been paid in sum of £218 & certificates of employees' liability insurance received.

115 Planning -

no further planning applications have been received. Cllr Evans-Swogger has attended a meeting where L.D.P was discussed. The consultation period has been extended to end of July. She pointed out that there were two 'windfall sites' in Tregeiriog. Council was aware of these & has no concerns.

116 Road & Lighting –

Cllr Bates (WCBC) has been in regular contact with Darren Williams, who replied “..the final details of the work programme are being detailed & will be published shortly..”. Cllr Bates has also been chasing Highways Dept regarding cutting verges. Cllr Greatorex was happy to report that further to his contact with Cabinet member Phyl Davies, Welsh Government

Highways, following The Three Castles Rally, planned structural work on the Rhiwlas road is to begin 16 July.

Community Councils will NOT require a data officer. Vision ICT will add a Privacy Statement to our website, which falls within GDPR guidelines.

Cllr Jones enquired where the money went & the Chairman informed the council that it went largely on education & roads. Cllr Bates should be able to provide more information at the next meeting.
