Minutes of meeting held on Tues 6th June 2017 7.30pm

Declaration of Interest:

Meeting was opened at 7.30pm. Cllr T Bates was welcomed & congratulated on his election.

Minutes of last meeting : Found to be a correct record. Prop. by Cllr K.L.Benning & Sec.by Cllr G.M.Jones

Matters arising – the meeting was declared quorate, with 4 members of the council present.

059 Police Report - No officer was present. Their emails noted that off-road patrols had operated in the area over last week end & no issues/events reported. The crime report showed that a speed survey had been carried out in Pontfadog 20 mph zone by officers & details passed to 'Go Safe' for analysis & actions.

On-going problem with Off-road vehicles. 17 warning letters issued to date; 1 x trials motorcycle seized & rider taken to court for traffic offences; 1 x section 59 issued to off-road vehicle; 5 x sheep reported dead – circumstances not confirmed; T.O.M.V – 3 males arrested & vehicle seized.

061 Llanarmon Youth Club – No further news, as scheduled meeting postponed due to half-term.

062 Public Conveniences - E-mail details of Chairman of Hall Committee have been given to Ms Garland of WCBC. We wait to hear if any progress is made on that front.

063 A.O.B –

Roads - thanks for works undertaken in Llanarmon & on the B4500 has been conveyed to David Pugh & Kevin Edwards of WCBC. It was also pointed out that vegetation growing from the wall on the bridge at the entry to Llanarmon requires attention, following Cllr R.Edwards observations at the last meeting; Cllr K.L.Benning noted that the works undertaken are welcome but there remain many issues on side roads & there did not appear to be 'joined up' thinking to undertake these works at the same time. There was a general feeling amongst councillors that there are many issues on minor roads that need correcting, particularly from Llanarmon towards Rhiwlas & culvert at Tregeiriog Mill.

Lighting – Unit 7 has still not been repaired. The Clerk has notified Paul Rogers WCBC, who apologised & will make further enquiries with Scottish Power. The Clerk will share correspondence with Cllr T.Bates WCBC, who will exercise his new authority on this old problem.

Bins & Rubbish Collection – Cllr E.M.Jones noted that following bin collections, there was more litter on the road !

Co-option - Cllrs will be required to co-opt a new councillor at the next meeting, on 11 July at 7.30pm
