Permission was given to issue a cheque in the sum of £150 to VCT for annual webhosting fee.

<u>223 Precept -</u> The amount has been fixed at £2000 for a number of years. This represents a sum of £12.42 per household. This is the third lowest in Wrexham CBC & compares favourably with Glyntrian £49.35 & Llansantffraid Glyn Ceiriog £62.76. Cllr Benning noted that the installation of CCTV had consumed a large proportion of our historic surplus & unless a specific need was identified, it would be sensible to remain unchanged, in light of the auditor's report on percentage surplus. The Chairman noted that the finger post requires some attention & flower tubs had been requested by the Youth Club. Cllr Bates enquired whether we had any other plans for forthcoming D-Day celebrations which may require funds. After some deliberation, it was proposed by Cllr Evans-Swogger & seconded by Cllr EW Morris & unanimously carried, to remain unchanged at £2000.

#### 224 Strategic Documents -

The Chairman is still reviewing strategic documents, which is time consuming. The clerk noted that some documents appear to have moved from the website. He will investigate with VCT publishing documents & format.

### 225 Council Structure

Cllr Benning continued with his comments at the last meeting, noting that there is some value in continuity ie. 3- or 5-year Chair-ship rather than the traditional one-year appointment alternating between wards. He also noted that the Chair should be digitally able, in today's environment. This does NOT exclude representation by those digitally less oble; it would be wrong to exclude 'wise, old heads.' We should encourage some younger people to become Councillors & may be consider a Junior Community Council. The Chairman asked for Councillors' views — Cllr W Morris thought that 5 years was probably too long & 3 years would be long enough! A 3-year term was proposed by Cllr GM Jones & seconded by Cllr EW Morris. Unanimously agreed.

He wished to put himself forward as a Community Council representative. In light of his previous experience, this was agreed. Proposed by Cllr Benning & seconded by Cllr GM Jones.
