327 Digital Voice Roll Out

Cllrs Benning & Bates had a meeting with Open Reach Executive. The future is a digital network; copper lines & exchanges will go. There are no masts & we are unlikely to get them. The Community is supplied by overhead powerlines & therefore there is always risk of power cuts. The Community Council needs to find ways to protect people in our community. How to get a message out? Who has generators or functioning routers etc? Age? vulnerability? We need to formulate a questionnaire & gather information on the members of the community, over the next few months.
